BIOGRAPHY

Mark L. Mazzanti is the Director of Business Management, Gulf Region Division. Prior to coming to GRD, Mr. Mazzanti served as the Chief of the Civil Works Integration Division, Programs Directorate, for the Mississippi Valley Division/Mississippi River Commission (MVD/MRC), U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

Mr. Mazzanti began his career in 1980 with the engineering firm of Kyle, Johnston & Associates in Dallas, Texas. In 1984, he came to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Vicksburg District, where he worked in the Planning Division and the Programs and Project Management Division, serving as a Study Manager, a Project Engineer and Chief of the Programs Management Branch. In 2003, he was selected as Chief of the Civil Works Integration Division and Deputy to the Director of Programs in MVD. From May-October, 2008, Mr. Mazzanti served as the Acting Chief of Programs Directorate. In these capacities, he oversaw development and execution of a civil works program in excess of \$13 billion, which includes full Federal funding for implementing Gulf Coast Recovery.

Mr. Mazzanti is a member of the Society of American Military Engineers and has received numerous awards over his near 25 year career with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers including the Commander's Award for Civilian Service, the Achievement Medal for Civilian Service and the Commander's Award for Outstanding Achievement in EEO.
