



Adya School gets 8 new classrooms

Al Fadha's Co. Ltd. of Baghdad renovated the Adya School in north Baghdad Province near Taji and built an addition for new classrooms and restrooms under a \$136,088 CERP-funded contract. That school serves 300 primary and secondary girls and boys and the expansion added 70% more classroom space. The existing structure of 390 sq. meters had its electrical, HVAC, and plumbing upgraded. The project also included a 280 sq. meter addition for eight new classrooms and two new bathrooms. The entire school got a new coat of paint. Construction started Oct. 9, 2005, and was completed April 22, 2006. An official ribbon cutting was conducted May 24.
